ATTENTION ALL STUDENTS: YOU ARE NOT ALLOWED IN THE TEACHER'S LOUNGE WITHOUT PRIOR PERMISSION.

The BOE policy is that ***students are not allowed to ride any bus other than the one they are assigned and may not ride home with friends.*** The only exception is if they ride the same bus and have a note or permission to exit at a different bus stop, but otherwise it is not allowed unless it's an emergency type

situation.

Due to too many incidents we are making changes to those that ride the Shuttle Bus over to BCH-If they ride a bus over to Beechnau at the end of the day they will sit on the bus until an adult from Beechnau comes to let them off. Once off the bus they will all use the path between Beechnau and the Church to walk to the front of Beechnau. If their parents are in Beechnau they will enter Door through Door 1, the front door.

ATTN STUDENTS: Please do not open the entry doors for anyone. A system has been established to ensure everyone's safety and should be followed. **This includes opening doors after school as well.** Anyone entering the building should be buzzed in or be with a coach or teacher. Thank you for helping keep our school safe!

ANOTHER REMINDER: If you do not have a practice or club after school, you may not stay after! No one should be in our building after school unless accompanied by a coach or teacher. NO MS students should be in the HS. Students must be on time to Saturday School. If you are not on time, you will not be permitted to serve your Saturday School and may need to serve further consequences for being absent.

Just a reminder that you are allowed only 8 unexcused absences a semester before you will need to attend Saturday school to make-up attendance hours. A parent phone call does not excuse an absence.

ATTENTION ALL STUDENTS WHO RIDE THE BUS: You will need to get right out to your bus after school because they will leave promptly at 2:34 p.m. Also, students coming from the parking lot or going to the parking lot, please remember to use the designated crosswalks, do not assume that the bus drivers will see you.

If you have not purchased your parking permit yet, please do so ASAP. We will be checking permits.

ATTENTION STUDENTS: Once you have entered the school, you ARE NOT permitted to leave without permission and you MUST sign out. The office must receive a telephone call or a note from a parent before you are allowed to leave. This also pertains to any athletes.
