School Annual Education Report (AER) Cover Letter

Dear Parents and Community Members:

We are pleased to present you with the Annual Education Report (AER) which provides key information on the 2023-2024 educational progress for Beechnau Elementary. The AER addresses the complex reporting information required by federal and state laws. The school's report contains information about student assessment, accountability, and teacher quality. If you have any questions about the AER, please contact Superintendent Greg Helmer for assistance.

For the 2023-2024 school year, schools were identified using definitions and labels as required in the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). A Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI) school is one that has at least one underperforming student subgroup. An Additional Targeted Support (ATS) school is one that has a student subgroup performing at the same level as the lowest 5% of all schools in the state. A Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) school is one whose performance is in the lowest 5% of all schools in the state or has a graduation rate at or below 67%. Some schools are not identified with any of these labels. In these cases, no label is given.

Our school has not been identified with any of these labels.

Although student achievement data has shown growth in the number of students demonstrating proficiency in reading, writing and math, we are working hard to improve. Several key initiatives have been undertaken to accelerate achievement and close persistent gaps. We recognize the importance of focusing on a consistent curriculum, therefore we continue to employ a curriculum director to facilitate the development of a common curriculum. We have adopted and implemented the Reading Street Program to further this goal. We continue to provide math, reading and ELL interventions for students who qualify for these services.

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State law requires that we also report the following information:

- 1. Beechnau Elementary School is the only elementary building in the district.
- 2. We are continuing to focus on increasing proficiency in reading, writing and mathematics scores for the bottom 30% of our students. We have implemented the Reading Street ELA program and are implementing the Bridges Math Curriculum.
- 3. Beechnau Elementary is a typical K-4 building, in a rural setting, in Muskegon County.
- Beechnau Elementary continues to follow the Common Core Curriculum in core academic areas. Common Core Curriculum maps can be found at http://www.corestandards.org or can be requested in the office.
- 5. The aggregate student achievement results for the 2022-2023 and the 2023-2024 School year are listed below.

6. During the 2022-2023 school year, 89% of the parents/guardians attended Fall Parent-Teacher Conferences and 88% of the parents/guardians attended Spring Parent-Teacher Conferences. For those that did not attend Parent-Teacher Conferences during the 2022-2023 school year, teachers made at least 2 attempts to reach them by phone. During the 2023-2024 school year, 94% of parents/guardians attended the Fall Parent-Teacher Conferences and 93% parents/guardians attended the Spring Parent-Teacher Conferences. For those that did not attend Parent-Teacher Conferences during the 2023-2024 school year, 3 contacts were made to try to reach the parent/guardian.

We hope that the data in this report is both useful and informative. Our continuous improvement plan focuses on improving our literacy and math achievement, while



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focusing on the whole child. As part of focusing on the whole child we have implemented a strong PBIS system. We have been identified as a Reward school and look forward to implementing new strategies and the potential to become one of the best elementary schools in the State of Michigan.
